

**Fortius SPORTSTRONG Contest
(the “Contest”)**

RULES AND REGULATIONS

THIS CONTEST IS BROUGHT TO YOU BY AQUILINI VANCOUVER LACROSSE LIMITED PARTNERSHIP (“AVLLP”) IN COOPERATION WITH FORTIUS INSTITUTE INC. (“MARKETING SPONSOR”). NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. CONTEST IS VOID IN WHOLE OR PART WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW. SEE ELIGIBILITY SECTION BELOW FOR FURTHER DETAILS. TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CONTEST YOU MUST READ AND AGREE TO THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS. PARTICIPATION IN THE CONTEST CONSTITUTES FULL AND UNCONDITIONAL AGREEMENT AND ACCEPTANCE OF THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS, AS THE SAME MAY BE AMENDED BY AVLLP FROM TIME TO TIME IN ITS SOLE DISCRETION UPON NOTICE (POSTING AMENDED RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE SUFFICIENT NOTICE). ALL DOLLAR AMOUNTS ARE IN CANADIAN DOLLARS (\$CDN) UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.

(1) CONTEST PERIOD:

The Contest will begin at 10:00AM (Pacific Time) on February 24, 2020 and end at 11:55PM (Pacific Time) on March 23, 2020 (the "Contest Period").

(2) ELIGIBILITY:

The Contest is open to boys and girls between the ages of 11 and 16 (as of the time of entry) who are resident in British Columbia. Entries will be accepted only from a parent or legal guardian of the child acting on the child’s behalf, and each prize must be claimed by the parent/legal guardian on behalf of the winning child. The children of employees of AVLLP or any of its affiliates which collectively with AVLLP operate as Canucks Sports & Entertainment (hereinafter “CSE”), the Marketing Sponsor or any of their affiliates, are not eligible to enter.

AVLLP shall have the right at any time to require proof of identity and/or eligibility to participate in the Contest. Failure to provide such proof may result in disqualification. All personal and other information requested by and supplied to AVLLP for the purpose of the Contest must be truthful, complete, accurate and in no way misleading. AVLLP reserves the right to disqualify any entry or entrant in its sole discretion, should any entry or entrant at any stage contain and/or supply untruthful, incomplete, inaccurate or misleading personal details and/or information.

(3) HOW TO ENTER:

No Purchase Necessary. To enter the Contest, please follow these steps:

1. Using a web browser, go to www.vancouverwarriors.com/sportstrong; and

2. Follow all instructions to enter, including completing and submitting the official Contest entry form.

There is a limit of one entry per person during the Contest Period, except that a parent/legal guardian may submit more than one entry if submitting on behalf of more than one child. Potential winners may be required to provide AVLLP with proof that the potential winner is the authorized account holder of the email address associated with the winning entry.

(4) PRIZE:

There will be one (1) prize available to be won, consisting of one (1) spot in a cycle of the Marketing Sponsor's SPORTSTRONG Youth Training, a 12-week group training program designed to help young athletes meet the physical demands of their sport, with one 60-minute training session per week.

The approximate retail value of the prize is \$420. All other costs associated with the prize including but not limited to transportation to and from the Marketing Sponsor's facility in Burnaby, B.C., travel insurance (if required), accommodations (if required), meals, taxes and items of a personal nature are the responsibility of the winner and their parent/legal guardian.

All prizes will be awarded and are provided "AS IS" without warranty of any kind, express or implied.

(5) WINNER SELECTION:

The prize winner(s) will be randomly selected on or around the end of the Contest Period from all qualified entries. Any potential winner will be contacted via phone or email within the first week following their random selection. Odds of winning a prize depend on the number of entrants who participate in the Contest.

The parent or legal guardian of the selected entrant will be required to correctly answer, unaided, a time-limited mathematical skill-testing question to be administered by AVLLP and to confirm his/her eligibility.

The parent or legal guardian of the selected entrant must also agree to sign and return AVLLP's standard Declaration and Release Form before being eligible to receive a prize.

If any selected entrant does not meet all of the Contest conditions, or does not reply within five (5) days of the initial documented contact attempt by AVLLP, that entrant will be disqualified and AVLLP shall be entitled to randomly select a new entrant from amongst the remaining eligible entries in accordance with these Rules and Regulations.

Once a potential winner is determined, the winning entrant will be directed as to how to claim their prize.

(6) GENERAL RULES:

This Contest is void where prohibited by law and is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations. All incidental costs and expenses not specifically referred to herein, including (without limitation) taxes, shall be the sole responsibility of the prize winner. To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, by entering the Contest, you agree to release and hold harmless CSE, AVLLP, the Marketing Sponsor, the National Lacrosse League and its Member Teams, and the respective governors, subsidiaries, affiliates, agents, directors, officers, employees and representatives of each of the foregoing (collectively, the “Released Parties”) from and against any and all liability, damages, claims, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorneys’ fees, or causes of action (however named or described) with respect to or arising out of: (i) your participation in the Contest, (ii) the receipt or use of the prize(s) awarded therein, or (iii) the administration of the Contest and the distribution of the prize(s) awarded therein.
