

**Panago Slay The Dragon Contest
(the "Contest")**

RULES AND REGULATIONS

CONTEST BROUGHT TO YOU BY VANCOUVER CANUCKS LIMITED PARTNERSHIP ("VCLP") IN COOPERATION WITH PANAGO PIZZA INC. ("PANAGO"). NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. CONTEST IS VOID IN WHOLE OR PART WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW. SEE ELIGIBILITY SECTION BELOW FOR FURTHER DETAILS. TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CONTEST YOU MUST READ AND AGREE TO THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS. PARTICIPATION IN THE CONTEST CONSTITUTES FULL AND UNCONDITIONAL AGREEMENT AND ACCEPTANCE OF THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS (AS THE SAME MAY BE AMENDED BY VCLP FROM TIME TO TIME IN ITS SOLE DISCRETION). (1) CONTEST PERIOD:

The Contest will begin at 3:00 PM (Vancouver time) on Wednesday, November 6, 2019 and end at 11:59 PM (Vancouver time) on Tuesday, November 26, 2019 (the "Contest Period").

(2) ELIGIBILITY:

In order to be eligible to win a prize, an entrant must be a resident of British Columbia, at least 19 years of age and must not be (and no member of his/her immediate family shall be) an employee of VCLP, Vancouver Arena Limited Partnership or Aquilini Food Services Limited Partnership (collectively operating as Canucks Sports & Entertainment, hereinafter "CSE") or Panago or any affiliate of the foregoing. For the purposes of these Rules and Regulations, "immediate family" means husband, wife, spouse, mother, father, brother, sister, son and/or daughter, whether by blood, marriage or adoption and whether or not they reside in the same household.

VCLP shall have the right at any time to require proof of identity and/or eligibility to participate in the Contest. Failure to provide such proof may result in disqualification. All personal and other information requested by and supplied to VCLP for the purpose of the Contest must be truthful, complete, accurate and in no way misleading. VCLP reserves the right to disqualify any entry or entrant in its sole discretion, should any entry or entrant at any stage contain and/or supply untruthful, incomplete, inaccurate or misleading personal details and/or information.

(3) HOW TO ENTER:

No Purchase Necessary. To enter the Contest, please follow these steps:

1. Using a web browser, go to canucks.com/slaythedragon; and
2. Follow all instructions to enter.

There is a limit of one entry per person. Potential winners may be required to provide VCLP with proof that the potential winner is the authorized account holder of the email address associated with the winning entry.

(4) PRIZES:

There will be four (4) prizes available to be won (one (1) grand prize and three (3) secondary prizes).

The grand prize will consist of the following:

- a set of four (4) tickets for the Vancouver Canucks vs. Ottawa Senators home game at Rogers Arena on Tuesday, December 3rd, 2019;
- dinner for four people in the Captains Room at Rogers Arena;
- a pre-game VIP tour of Rogers Arena for four people;
- a meet and greet with a Canucks celebrity; and
- four (4) \$100 Panago gift cards.

The approx. retail value of the grand prize is \$2000. All other costs and expenses associated with the grand prize, including without limitation transportation to and from Rogers Arena, parking, travel insurance (if required) and accommodation (if required), are the responsibility of the winner and his/her guests.

Each of the three (3) secondary prizes will consist of one (1) \$50 Panago gift card.

(5) WINNER SELECTION:

The prize winners will be randomly selected at the end of the Contest Period from all qualified entries. All potential winners will be contacted via phone or email within the first week following their random selection. Odds of winning a prize depend on the number of entrants who participate in the Contest.

A selected entrant will be required to correctly answer, unaided, a time-limited mathematical skill-testing question to be administered by VCLP and to confirm his/her eligibility.

A selected entrant must also agree to sign and return VCLP's standard Declaration and Release Form.

If any selected entrant does not meet all of the Contest conditions, or does not reply within five (5) days of the initial documented contact attempt by VCLP, that entrant will be disqualified and VCLP shall be entitled to randomly select a new entrant from amongst the remaining eligible entries.

Once a potential winner is determined, the winning entrant will be directed as to how to claim their prize, which will be delivered within a reasonable time.
