

**Toyota Junior Trainer for a Day Contest**  
**(the “Contest”)**

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

CONTEST BROUGHT TO YOU BY VANCOUVER CANUCKS LIMITED PARTNERSHIP (“VCLP”) IN COOPERATION WITH THE TOYOTA PACIFIC DEALERS ASSOCIATION (THE “TPDA”). NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. CONTEST IS VOID IN WHOLE OR PART WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW. SEE ELIGIBILITY SECTION BELOW FOR FURTHER DETAILS. TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CONTEST YOU MUST READ AND AGREE TO THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS. PARTICIPATION IN THE CONTEST CONSTITUTES FULL AND UNCONDITIONAL AGREEMENT AND ACCEPTANCE OF THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS (AS THE SAME MAY BE AMENDED BY VCLP FROM TIME TO TIME IN ITS SOLE DISCRETION). ALL DOLLAR AMOUNTS ARE IN CANADIAN FUNDS (\$CDN) UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.

**(1) CONTEST PERIOD:**

The Contest will begin at 12:00 PM (Vancouver time) on September 1, 2019, and end at 11:59 PM (Vancouver time) on January 5, 2020.

**(2) ELIGIBILITY:**

The Contest is open to boys and girls between the ages of 5 and 11 (as of the time of entry) who are resident in British Columbia. Entries will be accepted only from a parent or legal guardian of the child acting on the child’s behalf, and each prize must be claimed by the parent/legal guardian on behalf of the winning child. The children of employees of VCLP, any member of the TPDA or any of their affiliates are not eligible to enter.

VCLP shall have the right at any time to require proof of identity and/or eligibility to participate in the Contest. Failure to provide such proof may result in disqualification. All personal and other information requested by and supplied to VCLP for the purpose of the Contest must be truthful, complete, accurate and in no way misleading. VCLP reserves the right to disqualify any entry or entrant in its sole discretion, should any entry or entrant at any stage contain and/or supply untruthful, incomplete, inaccurate or misleading personal details and/or information.

**(3) HOW TO ENTER:**

No Purchase Necessary. To enter the Contest, please follow these steps:

1. Using a web browser, go to <https://contests.canucks.com/juniortrainer>
2. Follow all instructions to enter, including completing and submitting the official Contest entry form

There is a limit of one entry per person, except that a parent/legal guardian may submit more than one entry if submitting on behalf of more than one child. Potential winners may be required

to provide VCLP with proof that the potential winner is the authorized account holder of the email address associated with the winning entry.

**(4) PRIZES:**

There will be nineteen (19) prizes available to be won (one prize for each of the below seventeen (17) Vancouver Canucks regular season home games played at Rogers Arena, one prize for one (1) Vancouver Canucks pre-season game played at Save-On-Foods Memorial Center in Victoria, and one prize for one (1) Vancouver Canucks pre-season game played at Abbotsford Centre in Abbotsford as identified in the table below):

- i. opportunity for the winning child to sit with the trainers on the Vancouver Canucks bench during the pre-game warm up;
- ii. opportunity for the winning child to partake in a pre-game behind the scenes tour of the trainers' areas;
- iii. two (2) tickets to the game (for the winning child and one parent/legal guardian); and
- iv. one (1) Vancouver Canucks/Toyota co-branded jacket for the winning child.

The approximate retail value of each prize is two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00). All other costs and expenses associated with the prizes, including without limitation transportation, travel insurance if required, accommodations if required, meals, taxes and items of a personal nature are the responsibility of the winner and their parent/legal guardian. All aspects of prize are subject to availability and subject to change. VCLP and the TPDA reserve the right to make substitutions of prize elements in their sole discretion. Some additional restrictions may apply. Winner will be provided with additional details at time of prize fulfilment. VCLP and the TPDA reserve the right to adjust the number of prizes as a result of Vancouver Canucks game schedule changes.

**(5) WINNER SELECTION:**

The prize winners will be randomly selected from all qualified entries as of 12:00 pm (noon) on each of five (5) draw dates, as follows:

The parent/legal guardian of each selected entrant will be contacted via phone or email within the first week following their random selection. Odds of winning a prize depend on the number of entries received prior to the 12:00 pm (noon) deadline for each respective draw. Entries will

carry over from one prize selection to the next, except that no child shall be eligible to win more than one prize.

Before being declared a winner, the parent/legal guardian of the selected entrant will be required to confirm the selected entrant's availability to attend the relevant game and to sign and return VCLP's Declaration and Liability/Publicity Release Form and correctly answer, unaided, a time-limited mathematical skill-testing question to be administered by VCLP and to confirm the eligibility of the selected entrant.

If any selected entrant does not meet all of the Contest conditions, or does not reply within five (5) days of the initial documented contact attempt by VCLP, that entrant will be disqualified and VCLP shall be entitled to randomly select a new entrant from amongst the remaining eligible entries.

Once a potential winner is determined, the winning entrant will be directed as to how to claim their prize.

**(6) GENERAL RULES:**
